All persons (students, researchers, alumni) with the intention of legally founding a company at one of the Unite! partner universities or startups that have been founded after January 1st, 2023 are eligible to participate.

HOW TO APPLY

- · Hand in a pitch deck with 8-10 slides and
- A one pager in text (executive summary)
- To be included: a clear problem solution / product market fit, clear USP, business model, market analysis, ideally first revenues and a reference to the SDGs

PROCEDURE

- First phase: application until July 1st, 2024
- Second phase: online competition pitch in front of an expert jury
- Top 2 are invited to Darmstadt, Germany to participate the awarding ceremony (26th of September), chaired by the President of the Unite! University Alliance & jury members
- Free exhibition for the Top 2 @ the Startup & Innovation Day 2024 (same day)
